- Dredging the dock basin in front of North Cargo Berth III for handling of Vessels up to 14.20m draft including, turning circle at a cost of Rs. 253.57 Crores



- Development of Outer Harbour with two Container Terminals with 1000m quay length each and a draft of 16m at a cost of Rs.7056 Crores



- Widening of Harbour Entrance from 153 m to 230 m at a cost of Rs. 16.39 Crores.

Major Ongoing Projects

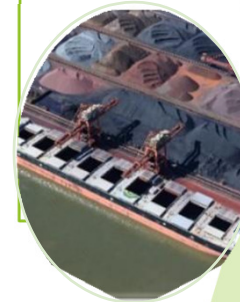
- Backup yard development at NCB II and III at a cost of Rs. 3.26 Crores and Rs. 3.69 Crores respectively.



- Commissioning of additional dolphins for handling smaller vessels at oil jetty at a cost of Rs.9.33 Crores



- Widening of approach road to North Cargo Berth-2 from yellow gate at a cost of Rs.7.14 Crores.

Major Ongoing Projects

- Capital dredging in front of NCB III up to (-) 15.1m to handle vessels up to (-) 14.20m draught and beam up to 40mtrs. (INR.118.37Cr)



- Providing cement concrete roads at Zone-B at a cost of Rs. 5.33 Crores.



- Improvement of marshalling yard and road connectivity for loading and unloading of cargo at a cost of Rs.7.50 Crores.
