## 9. Guard File TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The empanelled visiting consultant Specialist doctors will be engaged on fixed visits of two hours per visit for out-patient consultation with regular ward rounds to give opinion to the in-patients on their concerned specialty.
2. Duration of the emergency call visits will depend upon the condition of the patient to provide life saving treatment and such calls need not be for just a single patient.
3. The empanelled visiting consultants specialist doctors will render clinical services as per the existing terms and conditions and will be under the Administrative control of the Chief Medical Officer.
4. The Chief Medical Officer / Senior Deputy Chief Medical Officer will periodically monitor the performance of the visiting consultant specialist doctors.
5. Private dealings with any Port Trust patients are not permissible.
6. The empanelled visiting consultant specialist doctors are advised not to give an medical opinion or Medical Certificates to any employees of the Trust in his capacity as private practitioner for Port Trust purpose.
7. All empanelled visiting consultant specialist doctors have to maintain punctuality for out-patient consultations. They should stay for two hours in their consultation rooms for outpatient services.
8. The empanelled visiting consultant specialist doctors will inform over phone about leave, so as to avoid unnecessary waiting of the patients for specialist's consultations and embarrassment to hospital management.
9. The emergency visit calls of the empanelled visiting consultant specialist doctors are need based and compulsory, and not to refuse to attend the emergency calls without any valid reasons. If necessary, they may make use of ambulance services especially during night hours.
