TRADE NOTICE

Consequent to the revision of Berthing Norms which came into effect from 01.12.2015 and also based on the recommendations made by M/s. Boston Consulting Group (BCG), on improving the Performance of the Port, the output norms of coal handled at Berth No. IX is fixed at 24,000 Tonnes per day and at VOC 3 / VOC 4 it is fixed at 12,000 Tonnes per day.

2. In order to achieve the output norm of 24,000 Tonnes per day at Berth No. 9 the agency concerned are necessarily required to make use of atleast one Harbour Mobile Crane (HMC) in their vessel.

3. Hence, using of Harbour Mobile Crane (HMC) for discharge of coal is made compulsory to enable the users to avoid payment of penal charges on the vessels for not achieving the target output. If the users do not indent for HMC for handling of coal at Berth No. 9, their vessel will not be considered for berthing.

4. The above requirement comes into force from the date of issue of this Trade Notice.
