From the Desk of Chairperson



Shri Susanta Kumar Purohit, IRSEE Chairperson

Dear Friends.

It is my pleasure to welcome you to the second quarter edition of our Port's newsletter for the financial year 2025–26. The past three months have been a period of steady progress and notable achievements, which I am delighted to share with you.

Up to the second quarter of this financial year, our Port handled 21.29 million tonnes of cargo, registering a growth of 1.32% compared to 21.01 million tonnes handled during the same period last year. Our container operations also witnessed steady growth, with 4,28,096 TEUs handled, marking a 6.52% increase over the 4,01,902 TEUs handled during the corresponding period of the previous financial year.

A major highlight during this period is the dedication of North Cargo Berth–III to the Nation by Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister, on 26.07.2025. The terminal has already crossed the 2 million tonnes mark during its trial operations. The Port is now set to undertake significant infrastructure developments, including the creation of a new multicargo Berth No.10, construction of North Cargo Berth-4 for bulk cargo, strengthening of Berths 3, 4, and 7, and widening of the Port's entrance channel. Further, plans are underway to establish an Outer Harbour with a capacity of 4 million TEUs, along with shipbuilding and repair facilities, paving the way for VOC Port to emerge as a comprehensive maritime hub.

As part of our sustainability initiatives, the Port is expanding its renewable energy capacity with works in progress for an additional 1 MW ground-based solar facility and a 6 MW wind farm. Another major achievement in this quarter is the commissioning of the state-of-the-art Green Hydrogen Pilot Plant, inaugurated by Shri Sarbananda Sonowal, Hon'ble Union Minister of Ports, Shipping and Waterways. With a production capacity of 10 Nm³/hr, this pioneering initiative marks a historic milestone, making our Port the first Port in the country to produce Green Hydrogen.

Additionally, a pilot green methanol bunkering and refuelling facility with a storage capacity of 750 m³ is under development and expected to be completed by January 2026. This facility will further enhance investor confidence and strengthen the green fuel ecosystem in the shipping sector.

As we move forward, Port remains committed to excellence, sustainability, and innovation. I extend my sincere appreciation to all employees, stakeholders, and partners for their continuous support and dedication in driving the Port's growth and success.

Together, let us continue to build a greener, stronger, and more vibrant Port.

Port Performance

Traffic Performance

Port has handled 21.29 Million Tonnes of cargo up to the end of the second quarter of this financial year 2025–26, registering a 1.32% growth compared to the 21.01 Million Tonnes handled during the same period of the last financial year.

Operational Achievements




On 19.08.2025, Port has loaded 24 windmill blades, each measuring 59.18 metres in length, in a single shift, marking the highest number of windmill blades handled in a single shift at the Port.

On 21.08.2025, Port exported 101 windmill blades in a single ship, surpassing its previous record of 75 blades exported on 25.03.2025.

Solar and Wind Energy







More specifically, Port has achieved its highest-ever monthly renewable energy generation, generating a record-breaking 16,23,461 units of renewable energy in July 2025. This remarkable performance surpasses the previous best of 15,30,614 units, achieved just a month earlier in June 2025.



This renewable energy is generated through Port's 5 MW ground-based solar power plant, 2 MW wind turbine, and 1.04 MW rooftop solar power system.


