4. Bidder should have **(i)** Permanent Account Number [PAN]; **(ii)** GST Registration Certificate
5. Other details can be seen in the Tender documents. The Bidders are advised to read the whole document carefully and submit their tender/bid strictly, meeting the requirements spelled out in the bid document.
6. The bid document is required to be submitted only through e-tender web portal <https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app>.
7. While E-tendering all the supporting documents as stated in Annexure A have to be signed in each and every page serially numbered along with seal and shall be uploaded by the Bidders. No hardcopies need to be sent to the Authority.
8. The Authority will not be held responsible for any technical snag or network failure during online bidding.
9. The Authority reserves the right to cancel any or all bids without assigning any reason.

The following terms and conditions shall apply:

1. Rate : The rate quoted should be firm and final which includes cost of materials, transit arrangement and installation.

The bidder shall quote the rate in Indian Rupees and in English, in figures as well as in words, the rates tendered by him in the concerned proforma of the enquiry and in such a way that interpolation is not possible. The quoted amount for the work shall be entered in the enclosed format and duly signed by the bidder. In case of any discrepancy between figures and written words, the rates in words shall be taken as the quoted price.
2. General : The contractor shall make his own arrangements for carrying / Transporting the materials. Transporting charges shall be borne by the contractor. There is no need to mention each and every work in the schedule of work. The contractor is responsible to calculate the men and materials for the entire work.
3. Completion period : Completion period is seven days from date of issue of work order.
4. Payment : Payment will be made for Actual quantity of work done, to the entire satisfaction of Port authority.

Bill in triplicate with advance stamped receipt may be sent to the address of Executive Engineer, Electrical Division V.O.Chidambaranar Port Trust, Tuticorin – 4. for payment. PAN No. shall be indicated in the bill.
5. Liquidated damages : In case of any delay in completion of work, liquidated damages at 1% of the contract value for each week of delay subject to maximum of 10% of the contract value will be recovered from your bill or any amount due from you, subject to force majeure clause.
6. Genuiness : In case the work carried out by you is found not suitable by the consignee, you may have to rectify the defects at your cost immediately.
7. Income Tax ; Income tax will be deducted from the bill as per rules in force
8. GSTIN ; The CGST & SGST may be indicated in addition in your quotation.
