So, while we've had a positive growth in overall traffic, the Container traffic through the Port is witnessing a setback as the volumes are in a decreasing trend.

The fact that the container traffic volumes from Coimbatore, Tirupur, and Karur are shared mostly by 4 Port, it is a tough space to build businesses, and the optimum level of service must be offered by all stakeholders of the Port with grit and persistence to regain the volumes.

The month of September 2022 has been eventful with the visit of Shri Sarbananda Sonowal, Hon'ble Union Minister for Port, Shipping and Waterways & AYUSH and Dr. Sanjiv Ranjan, IAS, Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways. The month also witnessed the launching of the National Logistics Policy, by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, that would bring down logistics costs, give a fillip to international trade, help in making India self-reliant, usher in prosperity in the nation and present new opportunities to our start-ups.

I am also pleased to share with you all that the recent Green Port initiatives taken by the Port like Plantation drives, e-mobility, Solar Rooftop Power Plants, Wind energy, 100% LED Lightings, Power Trading through Indian Energy Exchange, public EV charging stations, etc., has been a trendsetter amongst all Major Ports of India.

PORT PERFORMANCE

Traffic Performance

V.O. Chidambaranar Port handled 19.32 Million Tonnes of cargo during this financial year upto September, 2022 as against 17.55 Million Tonnes handled during the corresponding period of previous year registering a increase of 10.09%.

The Port handled 3,90,138 TEUs. of containers during the current financial year upto the month September, 2022 as against 402.393 TEUs. of containers handled during the corresponding period of previous year, registering an decrease of -3.05%.

Operational Achievements

The Port created a new record by handling 36.76 Lakh Tonnes of cargo during June 2022, surpassing the previous highest handling of 35.99 Lakh Tonnes during July 2015.





The Port created a new record by handling 1,93,683 Tonnes of cargo in a single day on 11.07.2022, Surpassing the previous single day cargo handing record of 1,92,658 Tonnes handled during on 24.06.2022.

Raw cotton is being handled in break-bulk, for the first time at the Port. Ship with 17,914 Tonnes of cotton in bales were shipped from the Port of Douala (West Africa) on 31.07.2022
