From the Desk of Chairperson



Shri Susanta Kumar Purohit, IRSEE Chairperson

I am delighted to present the final newsletter of the financial year 2024-25. As we reflect on this year's journey, it is truly gratifying to witness the significant milestones and achievements that our Port has made.

In this financial year, the Port has efficiently handled 41.72 million tonnes of cargo, reflecting a growth of 0.78% compared to the 41.40 million tonnes handled during the same period last year. Our containerized cargo operations have also seen a strong 6.40% increase, with 7,95,222 TEUs handled, up from 7,47,363 TEUs, in the previous financial year. This remarkable progress reflects the dedication and hard work of everyone associated with the Port.

A major contributor to this growth has been our significant strides in infrastructure development. In January 2025, we commissioned two harbour mobile cranes with a capacity of 100 tonnes each. Recently, additional two harbour mobile cranes with a 100-tonne capacity arrived at the Port on 26.03.2025 . With these additions, our fleet now consists of seven harbour mobile cranes, with two more expected to join by May 2025. This expansion will accelerate cargo evacuation and reduce vessel turnaround times.

The Link Conveyor System connecting the conveyor of the Tuticorin Thermal Power Station and the Port's coal yard commenced operations, with the potential to enhance the coal handling capacity. Additionally, Berth-7 (formerly PSA SICAL Container Terminal) has been taken over by the Port.

A significant development underway is the dredging of North Cargo Berth-III to a depth of 15.10 meters, enabling the handling of vessels with a 14.20-meter draft. Following this, dredging will extend to the turning circle and channel area, increasing the turning circle's diameter from 488 meters to 550 meters. This critical enhancement, expected to be completed by May 2025, will further strengthen the Port's capacity to accommodate larger vessels efficiently.

In line with our commitment to renewable energy and green Port initiatives, our Port is constructing an exclusive terminal with two berths for handling heavy-duty windmill blades and accessories, which will contribute to the generation of 20 GW of wind power along the Tamil Nadu coastline. Additionally, plans are underway to construct a multi-cargo Berth No.10 with an LOA of 440 meters, further expanding our capabilities in handling diverse cargo. With these developments and our collective efforts, I am confident that we will achieve a cargo of 50 million tonnes in the financial year 2025-26.

I extend my heartfelt gratitude to all the employees, Port users, and stakeholders for their invaluable contributions to the Port's success. Together, we will continue to reach new milestones and establish ourselves as the preferred Port on the east coast of India. Thank you for your continued support, and I look forward to another year of gro

wth and excellence.

PORT PERFORMANCE

Traffic Performance

V.O.Chidambaranar Port handled 41.72 million tonnes of cargo in the financial year 2024-25, compared to 41.40 million tonnes handled during same period of last year, registering an increase of 0.78%.

The Port recorded a 6.40% growth in container traffic, handling 7,95,222 TEUs in the financial year 2024-25, compared to the 7,47,363 TEUs handled during the same period of the previous Financial Year.

Operational Achievements

Single Day Record

Container Handling



On 23.01.2025, the Port's container terminals handled 5250 TEUs in a Single Day, the highest single day container volume handled this FY 2024-25.

North Cargo Berth - II



On 01.02.2025, Port has created a new record by handling 30,789 Tonnes of cargo in a single day, surpassing the previous single day cargo handing record of 23,523 Tonnes handled at bulk cargo berth NCB II on 13.09.2024.

Total Cargo Handling



On 23.02.2025, Port has created a new record by handling 2,04,650 Tonnes of total cargo in a single day, surpassing the previous single day cargo handing record of 2,04,512 Tonnes on 30.10.2024.

Berth - 6

On 15.03.2025, the Port set a single day cargo handling record at Berth-6, by handling 30,352 tonnes of Coal, using harbour mobile cranes, surpassing the previous single day record of 18,365 tonnes on 01.03.2025.



Berth -3/4



On 21.03.2025, the Port set a single day cargo handling record at berth-4, by handling 33,952 tonnes of Coal, using harbour mobile cranes, surpassing the previous record of 32,000 tonness of coal on 13.02.2025 at berth-3/4.

PORT PERFORMANCE



The Port set a new record by handling 13 windmill blade-carrying ships in May 2024, surpassing the previous highest of 10 ships handled in July 2021.

Green Initiatives

The Port has made history as the first major Port in India to surpass 1 MW of rooftop solar power capacity. With the recent addition of a 400 kW offgrid rooftop solar system, the Port's total rooftop solar capacity now stands at 1.04 MW.







The Port has generated 1,03,52,733 units of renewable energy in the financial year 2024-25, through it's 5 MW ground-based solar power plant, 2 MW wind turbine, and 1.4 MW rooftop solar power system. These efforts have led to substantial carbon savings of 84,89,241 Kg of CO2, highlighting the Port's commitment to green energy and environmental sustainability.

Pradhan Mantri TB Mukth Bharat Abhiyaan
