V.O. Chidambarnar Port Authority is implementing the following Concession schemes for a period of two years i.e., 01.04.2024 to 31.03.2026

Category I: Container Vessel Related Concession/Incentive Schemes

SCHEME 1: Vessels connecting from/to Americas / Europe Continents:

Note:

- The above concession is in addition to the concession eligible for coastal shipping for coastal run vessels.
- This scheme is also applicable for the vessel connecting VOC Port with any other Indian Port and/or calling Colombo Port only in foreign segment.

SCHEME 5: Vessels connecting Colombo and not covered under Scheme 1 to 4

SCHEME 6: Concession for container vessels carrying Transshipment containers

Any container vessel, which brings in more than 100 TEUs of transshipment containers in a single voyage, will be eligible for 5% concession on VRC irrespective of availing/not availing any of the above concessions.

General Terms & Conditions for Category I:

- A. The operator/consortium proposing to operate regular service shall furnish schedule of calls and Port Rotation. Any change in Port rotation of the service shall be intimated to the Port. Under the declared service one or more Port may be included/excluded. Difference services could not be clubbed for calculate the number of voyages count.
- **B.** The applicability of the respective clause of concession shall be based on the Container Status Report (CSR) furnished by the Vessel Agent / respective Member of the consortium, duly certified by Master of the vessel and endorsed by respective Container Terminals. Concession shall be claimed by the vessel operator or consortium or his authorized agent.
- C. 1st slab concession shall be provided at the time of finalizing the VRC for the respective voyage. The VRC concessions for 2nd& 3rd slab, shall be claimed on or before 30 days, after the corresponding year, subject to fulfilling the conditions of the respective schemes.
- D. Voyages made under different schemes shall not be clubbed for calculating number of voyages. Each container vessel voyage is only eligible for any one of the schemes1 5 in Category I. The Concession extended under Scheme 6, if eligible, shall be claimed in addition to any other concession claimed/availed/not availed.

- E. No of voyages, slab is computed on annual basis (01.04.2024 to 31.03.2025 and 01.04.2025 to 31.03.2026) for two consecutive years.
- **F.** On achieving 2nd /3rd slab in number of calls, the operator/consortium/his authorized agent shall be eligible for concession for the entire voyages made by them irrespective of minimum volume in each voyage subject to achieving the average volume criteria in the respective slab.
- **G.** In case, On achieving 2nd /3rd slab in terms of the voyage and non achieving the average volume criteria, 1st slab concession will be extended to voyages that surpass the minimum volume criteria as per 1st slab.

H. Example for concession computation method for Category I:

Note:

- This method of calculation is applicable for Scheme 1-4
- For computation of No. of. Voyages and Average TEUs, all voyages shall be considered irrespective of volume handled in the respective voyage.

Category II: Other than Container Related Concession/Incentive Scheme:

Scheme 8: Concession for Transshipment of dry/ break bulk cargo:

If more than 1 Lakh MT & 3 Lakh MT of transshipment cargo is handled in the inward leg, the transhipper shall be eligible for 20% & 30% applicable concession, respectively, for the entire volume handled during the corresponding concession period.

II. BREAK BULK

If more than 10,000 MT & 50,000 MT of transshipment cargo is handled in the inward leg, the transhipper shall be eligible for 20% & 30% concession, respectively, for the entire volume handled during the corresponding concession period.

General Terms & Conditions under Category II:

- A. Scheme 7: Concession on applicable wharfage shall be claimed on or before 30 days, after the corresponding concession period.
- B. Scheme 8: Slab 1 concession on applicable wharfage for the cargo may be extended on finalizing the CRC for the respective voyage. Slab 2 & 3 concession on applicable wharfage concession shall be claimed on or before 30 days, after the corresponding concession period.
- C. Different commodities could not be clubbed for claiming the concession.
- D. Any user claiming concession under Scheme 8 must submit the relevant customs / other documents describing Transshipment through Tuticorin at the time of filing. If transshipment status is amended for domestic/local consumption, then concession and other applicable charges claimed, if any, shall be remitted before the delivery of cargo.
- E. Volume of transshipment cargo & Break Bulk Cargo handled up to the last date of the scheme period (annual basis 01.04.2024 to 31.03.2025 and 01.04.2025 to 31.03.2026) shall be eligible for the concession for the corresponding scheme period.
- F. Consignor/ Consignee / Importer/Exporter/transshipper directly or through their respective Cargo Related Agencies shall claim the concession w.r.t. individual cargo.
- G. This concession scheme is applicable for both EXIM and coastal cargo.
- H. Applicable Wharfage means after exclusion of any concessions from respective wharfage rate as per prevailing SOR.
